In the Philippines, these values are embodied by the Philippine Academy of Family Physicians, which was founded in 1959 and has since stood at the forefront of family medicine development in the country. THE HONOREE

RAMON R. ANGELES, MD, FPAFP

The Philippine Academy of Family Physicians launched the Dr. Ramon Angeles Memorial Lecture during its 45th Anniversary and Annual Convention in 2006. Now institutionalized in the By-Laws, the keynote address henceforth shall be named as such.



To those who joined the PAFP prior to 1994, “Tatang” as Dr. Angeles was later called, was a well known figure, a constant in all PAFP activities. For the younger members who did not get to know him, we are honoring the great old man of Family Medicine in the Philippines.

Dr. Ramon Angeles graduated from the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Santo Tomas in 1937. He went into general practice, interrupted only when he joined the military during World War II. A veteran of the Capaz Death March, he lost his right eye during the battle. This did not deter him from going back to practice in Quiapo, a practice he maintained up to a few months before his death.

In 1960, he led 14 other general practitioners to organize the then Philippine Academy of General Practitioners. Right from the beginning, he focused on quality care for patients and their families, continuing medical education of general practitioners and a dream of having a family physician for every Filipino family.

A very humble person, Dr. Angeles opted to stay in the background in various activities, providing inspiration and the much needed push or pat on the shoulder. He started the Postgraduate Courses which were combined with wet clinics. When the Filipino Family Physician was first published, he was Managing Editor, eventually becoming its Editor in Chief.

Prior to the transformation of the PAGP into a specialty society, he initiated meetings with deans of medical schools and directors of hospitals, trying to look for a model family medicine residency program. The Academy later developed into a specialty organization now known as the Philippine Academy of Family Physicians, recognized by the Philippine Medical Association and the Department of Health.

When the World Organization of Family Doctors (WONCA) was formed in 1972, he was in attendance together with Drs. Gregorio Lim and Romeo Montes, thus making the PAFP one of its founding member organizations.

When the Philippine Specialty Board of Family Medicine was put up, he was co-chairman, later becoming Chair or Chief Examiner. He co-edited the first book on the discipline, the “Fundamentals of Family Medicine.” When the PAFP purchased its own building, he wrote the initial paper on Family Health and Guidance, a dream still to be realized.

He and Dr. Romeo Montes supported the development of the Philippine Society of Teachers of Family Medicine. He thus, became its Honorary President and Adviser.

At a late age, he accepted the challenge to chair the Department of Family Medicine at St. Martin de Porres Hospital, one of the pioneers in solo programs.

He had been acknowledged and recognized by the PAFP on several occasions. He was given the first-ever Most Outstanding Family Physician award. In 1994, the PAFP Library was named in his honor.

The best recognition, however, that PAFP can give to its Founding President is by institutionalizing this **DR. RAMON R. ANGELES MEMORIAL LECTURE.**

DR. RAMON ANGELES MEMORIAL LECTURER

Prof. Eva Irene Y. Maglonzo, MD, MHPEd, FPAFP, FPCGM

Dr. Eva Irene Yu-Maglonzo, MD, MHPEd, FPAFP, FPCGM, is a distinguished Filipino family physician, educator, and leader in primary care and family medicine in the Philippines. She is a Past President of the Philippine Academy of Family Physicians (PAFP) and has long been dedicated to strengthening the role of family physicians in improving the health of Filipino families and communities.

Dr. Maglonzo serves as a Medical Specialist at the Philippine General Hospital and is a Professor at the University of Santo Tomas Faculty of Medicine and Surgery, where she teaches Preventive, Family, and Community Medicine and has served as Secretary of the Department of Medical Education. She has contributed to the development of outcomes-based curricula for medical students and family medicine residents and actively trains residents and medical interns in both UST and UP-PGH.

In her clinical practice, she also provides home-based medical care as an accredited physician of Home Health Care. In these various care settings, beyond medical management, she facilitates individual counseling and family meetings to support patients and their families in navigating health decisions and long-term care.

An advocate of holistic and community-oriented care, Dr. Maglonzo has worked with the Philippine College of Geriatric Medicine and the Department of Health in developing health policies for older persons and volunteers in community wellness programs, including conducting Comprehensive Geriatric Assessments in nursing homes. Her work also extends to research and publication, including authorship of *The Filipino Physician Today: A Practical Guide to Holistic Medicine*, which highlights the importance of comprehensive and patient-centered medical practice.

Her contributions to medical education and mentorship have been recognized with the UST Thomasian Award for Outstanding Alumni in Medical Education (2012) and as a finalist for the PCHRD Research Mentor Award (2009). Guided by her training in Family Medicine, Geriatric Medicine, and Health Professions Education, Dr. Maglonzo exemplifies the role of the five-star family physician—clinician, educator, researcher, advocate, and leader—dedicated to improving the health and well-being of Filipino families and communities.



WESS FABB ORATION AWARD

What is the Wes Fabb Oration Award?

The Wes Fabb Oration Award is the most prestigious recognition conferred by the World Organization of Family Doctors (WONCA) Asia Pacific Region. Established in 2002 in honor of Professor Wesley Earl Fabb, the first Chief Executive Officer of WONCA, the award celebrates a family physician who exemplifies excellence, leadership, and commitment to advancing Family Medicine and General Practice in the region.

The awardee is chosen through a rigorous nomination and review process conducted by the WONCA APR Nominations and Awards Committee and endorsed by the Regional Council. The selected recipient delivers the Wes Fabb Oration during the Opening Ceremonies of the WONCA Asia Pacific Regional Conference, sharing insights and inspiration drawn from their professional journey.

Through this award, WONCA APR recognizes individuals whose work strengthens Family Medicine education, research, service and collaboration, reflecting the enduring legacy of Professor Wes Fabb.

WONCA-APR 2026 in Iloilo, Philippines, marks the first time the Wes Fabb Oration is delivered in person in 12 years, since the 2014 conference in Malaysia. The Iloilo conference will also mark the second time the Philippines has the honor to host the Wes Fabb Orator, the first being in Cebu in 2011.



This year's Wes Fabb Orator and recipient of the Wes Fabb Oration Award, is **Dr. Donald Li, GBS, JP, MBBS FHKAM (Family Medicine) FHKCFP FRCGP FRACGP**

Dr. Donald Li is a specialist in Family Medicine and private practice in Hong Kong and Mainland China. He is the Chairman of the Elderly Commission of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Censor of the Hong Kong College of Family Physicians. Dr. Li is a Past President of the World Organization of Family Doctors (WONCA) and Hong Kong Academy of Medicine.

Dr. Li is Honorary Clinical Professor in Family Medicine and Primary Care of The University of Hong Kong, Honorary Clinical Professor in Family Medicine of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Honorary Professor of Shanghai Medical College of Fudan University.

Dr. Li is an active member of many governmental, non-government organization and public health bodies in Hong Kong and Globally. He is the Chairman of Action Committee Against Narcotics of Narcotics Division of Security Bureau, member of the Primary Healthcare Commission, Honorary Consultant of Department of Health, Director of the Hong Kong St. John Ambulance Association, Honorary Steward of Hong Kong Jockey Club. Dr. Li remains active in WONCA activities especially in finances, digital health and emerging primary models of family medicine.

ALLAN GEORGE R. DIONISIO, MD, FPAFP, FPSCOT 2026 Family Physician of the Year Philippine Academy of Family Physicians

Allan George R. Dionisio, MD, FPAFP, FPSCOT is a distinguished family and community medicine specialist, a highly esteemed clinical toxicologist, a staunch advocate for addiction medicine, and a well-loved marital and family life counselor with over four decades of impactful contributions to Philippine healthcare. His career exemplifies dedication to education, patient care, and public health, blending clinical expertise with innovative counseling approaches.



Dr. Dionisio earned the degrees Bachelor of Science in Zoology (1980) from the University of the Philippines (UP) Diliman and Doctor of Medicine (1984) from the UP Manila – College of Medicine (UPCM), followed by a Professional Diploma in Premarital, Marital, and Family Counseling (1991) from the Loyola School of Theology at the Ateneo de Manila University (ADMU). He completed his residency training at the UP Philippine General Hospital (UP-PGH) and his specialized post-residency training in Clinical Toxicology (1993) at the UPCM Department of Pharmacology. He likewise pursued international courses, including Clinical Toxinology in Australia (1999) and Addiction Medicine at the International Center for Credentialing and Accreditation of Addiction Professional – Colombo Plan (2015-2018). As a dedicated lifelong learner, he also trained in Occupational Safety and Health from UP Manila – College of Public Health (2023).

Dr. Dionisio is also a visionary leader, assuming key posts as Past Chair (2019-2021) of the UP PGH Department of Family and Community Medicine, as well as National President (2024-2025) of the Philippine Society of Clinical and Occupational Toxicology (PSCOT). He was at the forefront of initiatives for student health services and

advocacy campaigns for a drug-free working environment.

In addition, Dr. Dioniso is also passionate in teaching, being a true champion of the biopsychosocial approach to health; hence, he has been recognized as Outstanding Educator in Family Medicine (2011), awarded by the Foundation of Family Medicine Educators (FaMed). Auxiliary Commodore Nicolle Lourdes B. Dela Cruz, MD, MHM, FPAFP is a distinguished Family and Medicine Specialist and Occupational Safety and Health Practitioner whose career is defined by a profound commitment to the underserved. Currently serving as the Chair of the Department of Family and Community Medicine at Amang Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center (ARMMC), she has transformed the department into a powerhouse for community oriented health initiatives.



Dr. Dela Cruz is a proud Iskolar ng Bayan who obtained her Bachelor of Science in Biology (1994) degree from the University of the Philippines (UP) Manila. She graduated from the University of the East Ramon Magsaysay Memorial Medical Center (UERM) – College of Medicine in 2001, completed her post-graduate internship at the UP Philippine General Hospital in 2002, then pursued residency training in Family and Community Medicine at the University of Santo Tomas Hospital (USTH) in 2012. She likewise holds a post-graduate degree of Master in Hospital Management (2018) from the St. Joseph College of Quezon City and is currently pursuing Master in Public Management – Hospital Governance at the Ateneo de Manila University – School of Governance.

As a true lifelong learner, Dr. Dela Cruz never tires of gaining knowledge and has an insatiable desire to hone her clinical skills. She has successfully completed several local and international training workshops and programs, including (1) HIV Counseling from the Department of Health, (2) Supportive, Palliative, and Hospice Care from the Institute of Palliative Medicine in Kerala, India; and (3) Occupational Safety and Health from the Philippine College of

Occupational Medicine.

Dr. Dela Cruz has built an excellent platform for community-oriented health initiatives. Notably, she spearheaded “Kubo ni Amang” (KNA), a program dedicated to better the lives of the Dumagat Remontado indigenous population (IP) in Tanay, Rizal. The KNA allowed ARMMC health care professionals to regularly visit the adopted community in Brgy. Daraitan to provide basic health services. This endeavor dramatically expanded access to primary healthcare for the Dumagat IP.

Building on the success of KNA, this community-oriented program has expanded to pave the way for “Daraitan Tuesdays,” where Dumagat IP patients who warrant further diagnostic testing and/or referral to other specialty services are now shuttled to and from ARMMC and Brgy. Daraitan, Tanay, Rizal. This simple yet essential humanitarian act has reduced access barriers, improved continuity of care for chronic medical conditions, and provided tangible health gains for an underserved population, illustrating a scalable model for rural-urban health collaboration.

Dr. Dela Cruz’s commitment to service beyond the walls of hospital / clinic, outside her comfort zone, is further demonstrated by her passionate participation and voluntary work under the Philippine Coast Guard Auxiliary (PCGA), where she holds the flag rank title of an Auxiliary Commodore. In this capacity, Dr. Dela Cruz champions maritime safety, environmental protection, search and rescue, and community relations. As the Director Auxiliary Squadron (DAS) of the PCGA 124th Squadron, she has extended her advocacy to health, leveraging partnerships to promote health literacy, preventive care, and emergency readiness among Coast Guard personnel and their families. Her public health efforts have ensured that military and civilian personnel have better access to preventive services and medical referrals, even in challenging deployment contexts.

True to her philosophy of living life to the fullest, she directs initiatives in PCGA that ripple through communities, aligning all her advocacies with HIV/AIDS, animal welfare, gender and development, planetary health, climate change, as well as occupational safety and health. Her strongest quality is her ability to collaborate and build strong partnerships, even in the harshest resource-limited settings. Dr. Dela Cruz is a staunch advocate for “One Health” --- a viewpoint that centers on the intertwined well-being of people, animals, and the environment.
